

IPPA was created in December 2014 as a non-profit association to organize the International Conference on Public Policy. Its headquarters are based at ENTPE-LAET, University of Lyon, France.

In 2015/2016, IPPA had over 1000 members from more than 60 different countries and 13 Institutional Members and partners (APSA, IPSA, etc.).

#### OUR MAIN GOALS AND ACTIVITIES

- ◆ To promote scientific research in the field of public policy and to contribute to its international development, diffusion and promotion ;
- ◆ To organize a biennial International Conference on Public Policy (ICPP) [Grenoble, 2013 ; Milan 2015 ; Singapore 2017 ; etc.] ;
- ◆ To develop international network activities which contribute to the Public Policy sector by supporting regional or local conferences (Cotonou 2015 ; Hong Kong 2016, etc.) ;
- ◆ To manage a website and send regular newsletters to inform the entire community about conferences, networking, books and articles, jobs, teaching resources, etc. (Newsletter distributed every 2 weeks to more than 4000 researchers) ;
- ◆ To initiate IPPA Summer Schools and Training Courses for PhD students, young researchers, practitioners, etc. ;
- ◆ To support public policy research with our own publications on public policy *International Series on Public Policy* (Ed. Palgrave-McMillan).

## PRESENTATION

Over the past 40 years, public policy research has grown as an academic research field studied in many countries. Involving a range of disciplines in the social sciences and humanities, including political science, public administration, geography, sociology, economics and law among others, this research has helped to develop our understanding of many phenomena related to public policy.

To integrate this important but too often fragmented research, the first International Conference on Public Policy (ICPP) was organized in 2013 in Grenoble (France) and met with incredible success with over 900 participants from more than 60 countries. To continue this momentum, a second conference took place in Milan (Italy) in 2015 and included more than 1300 researchers who gave presentations and transformed ICPP into the biggest international event in the policy field.

The ICPP creates opportunities for various disciplines to present and discuss new research as well as theoretical, conceptual and methodological insights and empirical findings through a symposium of selected panels and 3 Plenary Sessions.

ICPP is designed to offer a great quality of exchange between attendees. To do so, carefully selected panels and papers are presented over two hours to allow time for discussion. Collective events are also organised to facilitate interaction between participants (Gala Dinner, lunches, etc.).

The third International Conference on Public Policy will take place **at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (NUS), in Singapore, from Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2017.**

**A preconference is proposed on Tuesday, June 27<sup>th</sup> 2017.**

## TIMELINE OF THE 3<sup>RD</sup> ICPP

This is a 3-day conference with multi-sessions and plenary roundtables. The conference call is structured in 3 steps :

### 1 | CALL FOR PANELS //////////////////////////////////// September 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 → October 14<sup>th</sup> 2016

During this period, researchers can propose a panel on Public Policy through our website by sending us an abstract of no more than 500 words. This text should introduce the focus or topic of the panel, explain its scientific relevance and the text for the "call for papers" if the panel is selected. Panel proposals can be on any specific topic : theoretical, methodological, or empirical approaches are all welcome. The selection will be made by the Scientific Committee.

### 2 | CALL FOR PAPERS //////////////////////////////////// November 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 → January 16<sup>th</sup> 2017

During this period, all researchers can propose a paper for one of the panels selected and published on our website, referring to its "call for papers". The proposal must contain a title and an abstract of no more than 300 words. The panel chairs will select papers and can organize between 1 to 3 sessions during the conference. Each session will contain 4 to 5 papers.

### 3 | CONFERENCE REGISTRATION //////////////////////////////////// Opens January 16<sup>th</sup> 2017

**Before the 31<sup>th</sup> March 2017** : registration fees are 190€ for IPPA members and 130€ for IPPA Student members.

**For the period 1<sup>st</sup> April – 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017** : an extra cost of 100€ will be applicable.

**After the 1<sup>st</sup> of June** : an extra cost of 200 € will be applicable.
